To Our Learning Community,

As you may be aware, the State of Illinois recently approved a bill this year that requires elementary schools and daycare centers to test drinking fountains, sinks and other water sources for lead. The new law requires school districts to test water sources used for drinking and cooking.

Schools built before 1987 that educate K-5th grade students must test their water by Dec. 31, 2017. The law also requires organizations to notify parents of those results.

All fountains and sinks used for drinking and cooking were tested for lead at both Newark Grade School and Millbrook Jr. High. I am very happy to report that all water sources were below the allowable lead levels at both schools.
