- **NGS School Times:** Students will be supervised after 7:40 AM. The first bell rings at 8:05. Late bell rings at 8:10. Anyone arriving after 8:10 will be marked tardy. Students are dismissed at 3:05. Bus riders are dismissed first followed by car riders and walkers.
- **MJH School Times:** Shuttle Bus **leaves** NGS Parking Lot at 7:52 AM for MJH. MJH starts at 8:05AM. Students are dismissed at 2:57. Shuttle Bus arrives at NGS 3:05 – 3:10 pm.
- **Lunch Prices:** We receive Federal Monies to offset the cost of school lunches, therefore we must be in compliance with their pricing and portion sizes. NGS and MJH Lunch Prices this year are \$3.00 per lunch. Milk prices remain the same at \$.35 for a milk.

- **If your child is sick – call in before 9:00 AM.** Talk to your child's school secretary - Julie Hauge or Tricia Wood. If you do not call in by then, we will call you. This is to prevent lost children.
